 - 2

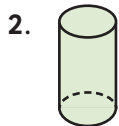
Activity 2

Choose the example that matches the property.

- Property of Zero
 - $\frac{1}{2} + 0 = \frac{1}{2}$
 - $\frac{1}{2} \cdot 0 = 0$
 - $\frac{1}{2} + -\frac{1}{2} = 0$
- Property of Reciprocals
 - $\frac{2}{3} \cdot 1 = \frac{2}{3}$
 - $\frac{3}{5} + 0 = \frac{3}{5}$
 - $\frac{4}{6} \cdot \frac{6}{4} = 1$
- Identity Property
 - $4 \cdot 1 = 4$
 - $4 \cdot 0 = 0$
 - $4 + -4 = 0$
- Inverse Property
 - $3 + 0 = 3$
 - $3 + -3 = 0$
 - $3 \cdot 1 = 3$
